One in four players or the greater part thereof, to qualify for the final day's play. League Secretaries must send in all results and entry sheets together with full entry fees. **(Inc qualifiers contact details)** To the **COMPETITION SECRETARY: By 12.00 noon, 18th May, after the Qualifying Round.**

- PRACTICE:** Except for pre-arranged fixtures. (As defined in Competition Rule 9)
- QUALIFYING ROUNDS:** No practice on the qualifying green once that qualifying green has been announced.
- FINAL DAY:** No practice on the Final Day Venue once a player has qualified for the Final Day's play, no player to qualify on his own green or allowed to enter in more than one area. Any violation of this or the practice rules will entail disqualification.
- IMPORTANT:** B.C.G.B.A. rules only permit a player to enter one County Merit in any one season
